Stitch Count 28 x 40

Note: Always cut the fabric at least 6 inches bigger than the finished design measurements to allow for framing of small size projects.

1. Use 2 strands for Cross stitch. Use 1 strand for Back stitch & French knots.
2. Line up the arrows to find the centre of the chart.
3. Find the centre of the fabric. Work from the centre of the chart, referring to the key.
4. One symbol on the chart represents one stitch.
5. Complete all Cross stitches before adding Backstitch. French knots are always added last.
