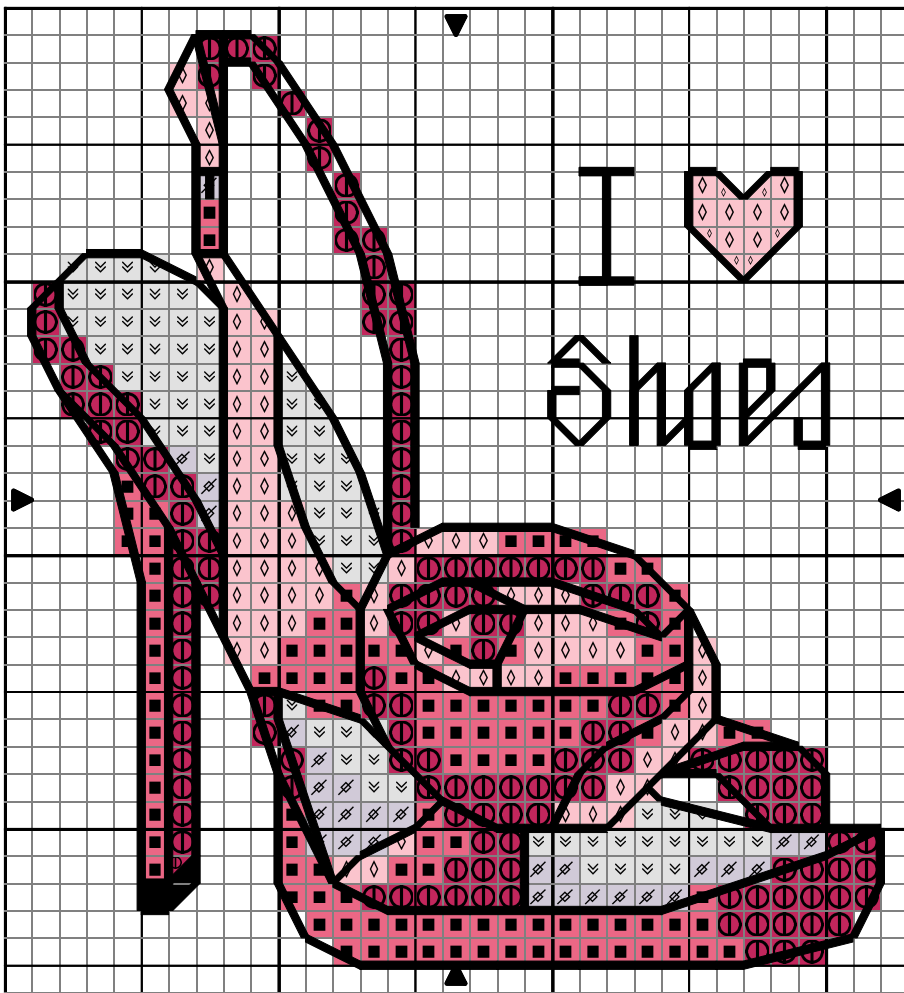

Pattern Notes

1. Use 2 strands of thread for Cross Stitch & 1 strand for Back Stitch and any French Knots.
2. Find the centre of the fabric. Work from the centre of the chart (the point where the arrows cross), referring to the key.
3. One symbol on the chart represents one Cross Stitch.
4. Complete all Cross Stitches before adding Back Stitch. French Knots and beads are added last (if the design contains them)

Remember to cut the fabric larger than the design measurements - add 6 inches to both the width & height for smaller projects and cards and 8 inches for medium size projects. This allows for finishing and framing.
