

Time for tea



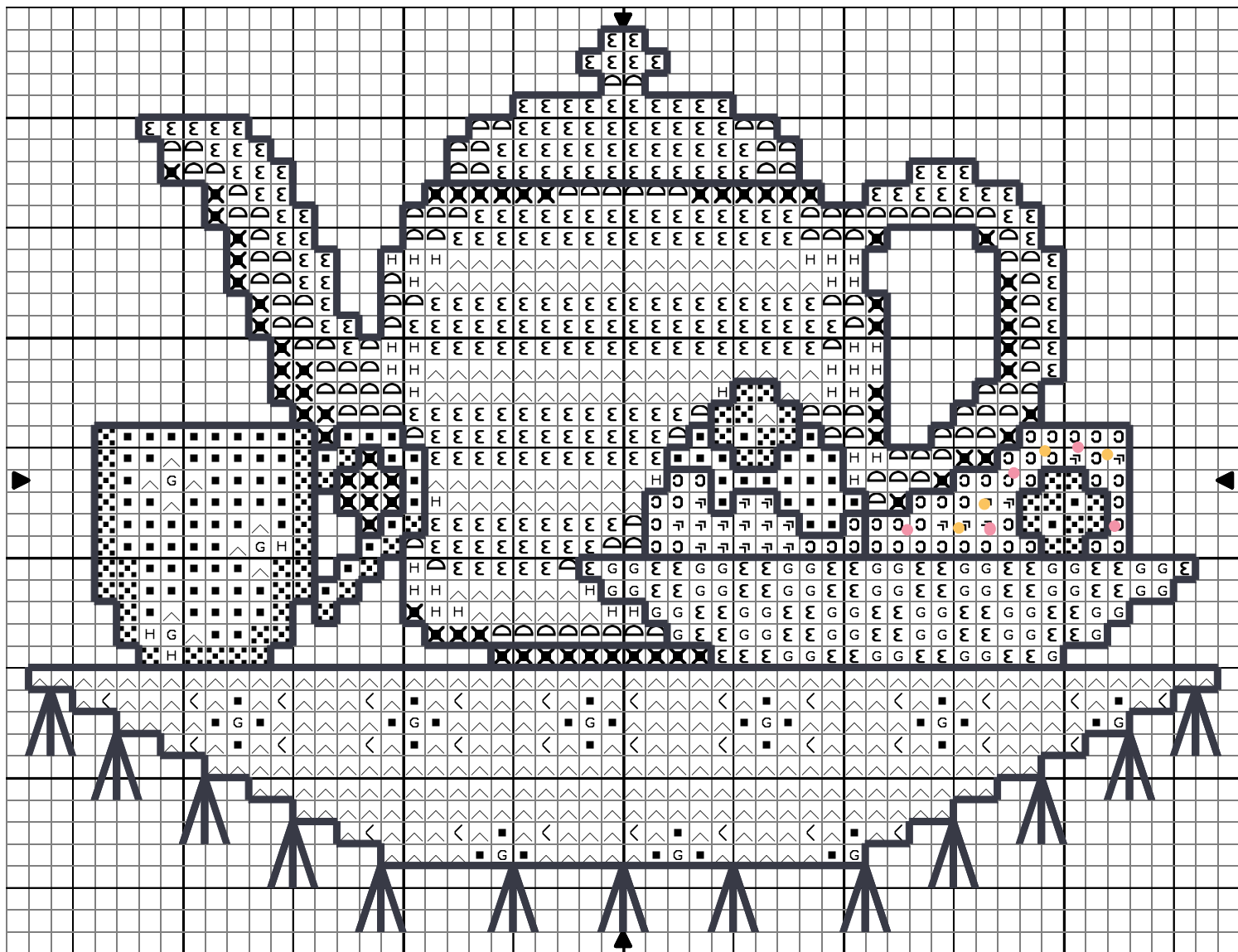
Suitable for beginners - contains only whole Cross Stitch and Back Stitch. The French Knots could be changed to seed beads instead.

Backstitch in:

— Anthracite grey 3799

French Knots in:

● Candyfloss pink 3716 ● Medium yellow 743

Stitch Count 54 x 41

Design Area 3 7/8 x 2 7/8 inches at 14ct

Note: Always cut the fabric at least 6 inches bigger than the finished design measurements to allow for mounting of small size projects.

1. Use 2 strands for Cross stitch. Use 1 strand for Back stitch.
2. Line up the arrows to find the centre of the chart.
3. Find the centre of the fabric. Work from the centre of the chart, referring to the key.
4. One symbol on the chart represents one stitch.
5. Complete all Cross stitches before adding Backstitch.
